

Sparklers @ Home Week 5

Hello Sparklers! I hope you enjoyed last week's session with drawing around your feet. This week we will be looking at what happens after Easter when Jesus had risen from the dead and went up to Heaven to be with God. We will be reading our story, doing our colouring sheet and creating paper daffodils.

1. First let's do our colouring sheets and making them into flags! A larger example will be available at the end of this session.



2. Print out and copy of the sheet and then cut out the picture. Colour it in and then wrap the left side around a garden cane or something similar.

3. Next week are going to be doing our craft which is paper daffodils. Your will need help from your parents to do this activity.



You will need:

Yellow A4 card

Green A4 card

Scissors

Glue

Sellotape

Paper cupcake cases

Pencil

First draw a flower shape on your yellow card and then cut it out.



Then roll one sheet of your green card into a thin tube, stick it together with sellotape and stick the flower at the top with your gluestick.





Then stick a cup cake case in the middle of the flower shape. Then cut out a circle shape from the yellow card and stick it in the middle of the cup cake case.



You can then display your flowers in a nice cup or vase. This reminds us of new life that comes in the spring including new flowers and new animals being born but also the new chance we have to be part of God's family because Jesus died for us and forgave our sins.

4. We are now going to read our story which can be found in Luke 24 v 50-53 or Acts 1 v 9-11.

⁵⁰ And He led them out as far as Bethany, and He lifted up His hands and blessed them. ⁵¹ Now it came to pass, while He blessed them, that He was parted from them and carried up into heaven. ⁵² And they worshiped Him, and returned to Jerusalem with great joy, ⁵³ and were continually in the temple  praising and blessing God.  Amen.

Then they gathered around him and asked him, "Lord, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?"

⁷ He said to them: "It is not for you to know the times or dates the Father has set by his own authority. ⁸ But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

⁹ After he said this, he was taken up before their very eyes, and a cloud hid him from their sight.

¹⁰ They were looking intently up into the sky as he was going, when suddenly two men dressed in white stood beside them. ¹¹ "Men of Galilee," they said, "why do you stand here looking into the sky? This same Jesus, who has been taken from you into heaven, will come back in the same way you have seen him go into heaven."

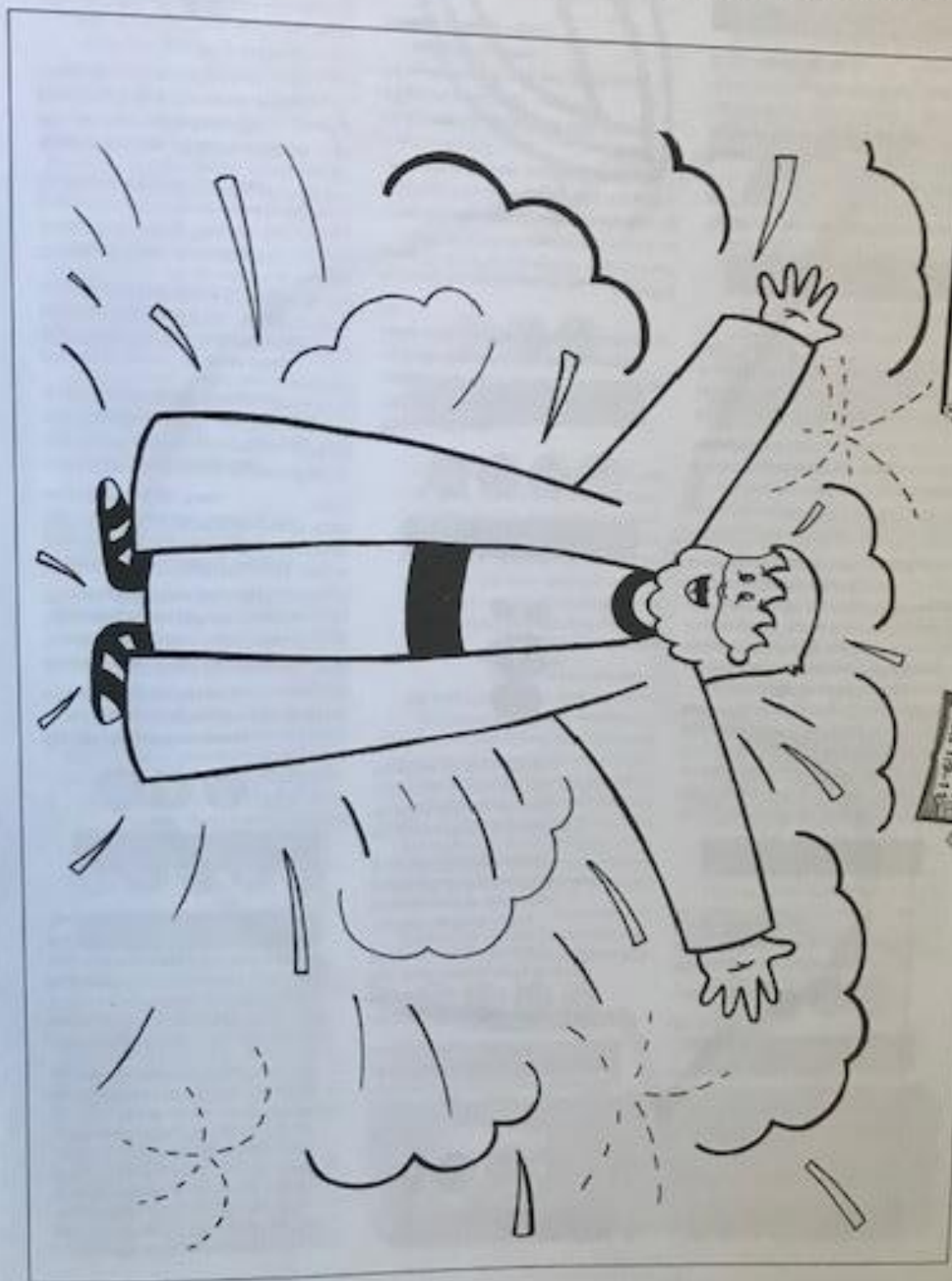
