Hi Sparklers,

This week we finish our story about David. This week the good king David gets things very badly wrong.

Activity One – Starting again!

Have fun with playdough. Or chalk and boards

Do you notice that at times you squash the playdough and start again or rub out the chalk and draw again? We are going to hear in the story today the same was true for David although things went wrong for David, he could start again.

Bible Story.

Print out today's bubbles sheet from the back we will use the pictures as we listen to today's story.

King David really loved God. And God had given David so much! He was a powerful king; he had a lovely palace, lots of money and lots of sheep and cattle. But one day David did something very wrong – he took something that didn't belong to him. God was sad that David had done this wrong thing. But David did not feel sad. No, not at all.

(What do you think God did about it?)

God sent a man called Nathan to talk to David. (find the picture of the King with another man there are two pictures that look quite similar look for the number 1).

God sent Nathan to tell David a story. It was about a rich man who had lots of sheep. Nathan said, "King David, there was once a rich man who had lots of sheep. (Find the second picture) There was also a poor man, who had just one little lamb (a young sheep). (Third picture). But the rich man took away the poor man's lamb" (Fourth Picture).

(Who did something wrong in Nathans story? The poor man or the rich man? – that's right the rich man. How would the poor man feel when his one Lamb was taken from him? fifth picture).

King David was angry when he heard this story. "The rich man did something very wrong!" he shouted. Nathan said, "David, you are like the rich man. You have everything you need, but you still took something that did not belong to you." (*Picture six*).

When David heard this, he knew he had done wrong, just like the rich man in Nathan's story. Then David felt sorry for doing wrong. He though no one knew – but God knew! David said, "I'm sorry," to God and God said, "I forgive you, David."
