Solomon Praises God 1 Kings 8:1-13, 54-66

Hi Sparklers,

Last week we heard about King Solomon building the temple. It's now finished so this week we are going to hear what happened next.

<u>Activity – Praise Temple</u>

Get a big sheet of paper and draw on it the outline of a temple.

Then using pritt-stick or another glue. Stick on bits of gold (yellow is fine if you don't have gold) paper to decorate the temple.

Write on Bubble shapes on paper "Praise God"

Next draw pictures of things you are thankful to God for (it can be anything).

Cut out these pictures and stick them in your temple picture. Stick the "Praise God" bubbles you created above these pictures.

When you have finished you can say the following prayer:

"Thank you, God, that Solomon praised you in the Temple. Thank you, God, that we can praise you today."

Bible Story.

Last time, we heard that King Solomon had started building the special Temple for God. All the workmen did their very best to make God's Temple a beautiful place. They use wood and stone to build. They covered it with shiny gold and bronze. At last, it was finished! It was very big and very beautiful.

Solomon called all the people together to have a special celebration.

All the people came in a big procession up to the Temple. They prayed and sang to God.

They all reached the Temple. King Solomon prayed a special prayer to praise God and to thank him for his love.

Everyone was so happy because God's beautiful Temple was finished. Now people from all over the world could come and worship God together.
