

**Week 48 Psalm 93, Revelation 1:4-8, John 18:33-37**

*26th The Lord reigns. He is robed in majesty*

Worship almighty God, who is also our Father. Pray for the Advent Course which starts today. Pray that we can become like Jesus, willing to come alongside and help those in need. Pray for Hope into Action.

*27th Grace and peace to you from him who is...was...is to come*

Praise and worship our Saviour, Jesus Christ, who was willing to go to the cross for our sakes. Pray that we will be sensitive to the needs of those who struggle with disabilities of one kind or another, for suitable accommodation, and for those who care for them. Pray for the shops along the Thoroughfare and in the Turban Centre. Pray for Christian Aid.

*28th I am the Alpha and the Omega*

Pray for the Alpha Course, pray that God will give us the words to say to our own families, to children and grand-children. Pray for the County Council and the District Council and the services they provide. Pray for Barnabas Fund. Pray for the Salvation Army and other organisations which reach out to the hungry and the homeless.

*29th My kingdom is from another place*

Pray for God's kingdom – on earth as in heaven. Pray for Christians in this country who are being taken to court or sacked because they hold onto and express their faith. Pray for the other churches and chapels in Woodbridge and Melton, their ministers and people. Pray for the people and church at Bredfield.

*30th I came...to testify to the truth*

Pray for God's truth to prevail over the distortions and lies that we hear from the world around us. Pray for anyone we know who is searching for some meaning in their life, for healing, for restoration of relationships, that they will respond to Jesus. Does God want you to come alongside them? Pray for the Town Pastors and the police. Pray for Healing on the Streets.

**Week 45 Psalm 119:1-8, Mark 12:28-34**

*5th Blessed are they...who walk according to the law of the Lord*  
Ask God to help you live by his law. Pray for God's kingdom on earth. Pray for this nation, and for our government that decisions made will be to the benefit of all and not just a few. Pray for the work of The Children's Society.

*6th Blessed are they who...seek him with their hearts*

Pray for Alpha in St Johns and worldwide. Pray for the leaders of groups. Pray for those of our fellowship who are housebound, and for their carers, that we will support and not forget them. Pray for Just 42. Pray for the Marriage Course.

*7th "Love the Lord your God..."*

Come before the Lord and offer him your whole-hearted love. Give thanks for all who help to sustain the life of St Johns as volunteers and ask God if he is calling you to a particular area of service. Pray for Clive and Mary.

*8th "Love your neighbour as yourself"*

Pray for your neighbours. Pray that we can put aside any prejudice and see God's image in every person. Pray for David and Ivan, our Churchwardens and those who warden each service. Pray for Cafe Church.

*9th "You are not far from the kingdom of God"*

As we learn to love God and to love our neighbour we become part of God's kingdom, here on earth. Pray for his kingdom. Pray for those who offer prayer ministry in St Johns and elsewhere, including Healing on the Streets. Pray for the Town Pastors and for the police. Pray for the Remembrance Day service.

**Week 46 Psalm 62:5-12, Hebrews 9:24-28, Mark 1:14-20**

*12th My soul finds rest in God alone*

Praise God for his love and faithfulness in our lives, our homes, our marriages and families, and put your trust in him to give you rest in the business of our lives. Pray that we the people of St Johns recognise the Lordship of Jesus and treat each other equally. Pray for Open Doors. Pray for the Life Groups and their leaders.

*13th He alone is my rock...*

Ask God to forgive us for the times we place our trust elsewhere. Pray for the ministry of St Johns to children and young people:- Pray for Andy and Michele. Pray for Clare. Pray for our outreach to schools through assemblies and Open the Book. Pray for our children and young people and their teachers and leaders. Pray for CPAS and the work among young people.

*14th ...I have heard...that you O Lord are loving*

Pray for those who find it difficult to accept that God loves them. Pray for the bereaved. Pray for our brothers and sisters in Christ who are being killed or persecuted for their faith. Pray for those who live or work in the residential and care homes in Woodbridge. Pray for the Wednesday congregation. Pray for Alpha.

*15th Christ was sacrificed once to take away the sins of many*

Offer up praise for Christ's sacrifice, bringing us closer to God. Pray for your neighbours- where you live, or work or meet. Pray that each of us can take part in the ministry of encouragement to one another. Pray for the Gideons. Pray for Noelle, Lois and the office volunteers.

*16th Come, follow me*

Ask God to show you how you can obey the calling, to all his people, to make his name known throughout the world. Pray for the church as it comes together to worship on Sunday. Pray for the Town Pastors. Pray for Healing on the Streets.

**Week 47 Psalm 16, Mark 13:1-8**

*19th the boundary lines have fallen for me in pleasant places*

Pray for all who care for the environment – ourselves as individuals and for organisations. Give thanks for all those who teach God's word in St Johns and the other churches in Woodbridge, to adults and children. Pray for OMF, the Pawsons and Heather Cox.

*20th I will praise the Lord who counsels me*

Ask for forgiveness for the times we get it wrong. Pray for revival in this nation, which has become a desert, lacking knowledge of God and without love and compassion for one another. Pray for our part in this revival. Pray for the Sunday morning Congregation. Give thanks for those who clean the church, those who maintain it and those who decorate it with flowers making it a welcoming place week after week.

*21st You have made known o me the path of life*

Pray that we will listen and think first, then speak after. In all the circumstances of life pray that you will turn to God first, before anything or anyone else. Pray for this nation to accept God's kingship and guidance. Pray for our musicians and all those who support the services in St Johns through sound and vision. Pray for Cry in the Dark.

*22nd Look...what magnificent buildings*

Pray that we will not be taken in by outward appearances, but look for what lies at the heart. Pray for the homeless and those who struggle to make ends meet. Pray for the Samaritans and other organisations which reach out to help the suicidal and the desperate. Pray for the Bible Society.

*23rd Watch out that no one deceives you*

Ask God for wisdom as we hear conflicting views from politicians and the media. Pray for the service of baptism and confirmation on Sunday and for Bishop Mike. Pray for the Town Pastors. Pray for Crosslinks and the Robinson family.
