*22nd Come all you who are thirsty...*

God trusts us to work alongside him in the world offering the water of life to our neighbourhood. Ask him how to be a Messenger of the Gospel the theme for Sunday. Pray for Crosslinks and the Robinson family. Pray for Healing on the Streets and for the Town Pastors.

**Weekend Pray for your family**

*25th Seek the Lord while he may be found*

Pray for those you know who are open to receive. Tell God your concerns for this world that he created and that we are ruining with climate change. And pray for people influenced by or at the mercy of extreme politics and fundamentalism in many countries. Pray for The Hub

*26th When your are tempted he will also provide a way out...*

We are all tempted at one time or another. Ask God to uphold you, to firmly stand against the temptation. Pray for those addicted to drugs, alcohol, sex and other less obvious but very real temptations. Pray for Christian Aid and its work throughout the world.

*27th Unless you repent you too will perish*

It sometimes seems that this world will drown through climate change, or the accumulation of plastic waste. Pray that God will save us from ourselves. Call to him now on behalf of the people of the world. Pray for this nation, that we will return to the Lord, full of love for him and for one another. Pray for Barnabas Fund. Pray for food banks and for the Salvation Army and other organisations which reach out to the hungry and the homeless.

*28th Leave it alone for one more year...*

Give thanks that God does offer us chances to change. Come to him now repent of any persistent sin and ask him for the strength to overcome. Pray for God's kingdom – on earth as in heaven. Pray for the other churches and chapels in Woodbridge and Melton, their ministers and people. Pray for the people and church at Bredfield.

Holy ~ Compelled ~ Fruitful**

**Exodus 34:29-35, 2 Corinthians 3:12-4:4, Luke 9:28-36**

*1st [Moses] face was radiant*

Give thanks for people who you know who glow with love for the Lord. Pray for God's kingdom on earth. Pray for this nation, that decisions made by government will be to the benefit of all and not just a few. Pray for the All Age Service on Sunday. Pray for the work of The Children's Society. Pray for the Town Pastors and for the police. Pray for "Who Let the Dads Out" and its outreach to men.

**Weekend Pray for your family**

*4th Whenever anyone turns to the Lord the veil is taken away*

Ask God to open the scriptures to you, bringing understanding of God's word and its fulfilment brought by Jesus. Pray for the leaders of our Life Groups. Pray for those of our fellowship who are housebound, and for their carers, that we will support and not forget them. Pray for Just 42. Pray for The Hub.

*5th We...are being transformed into his likeness*

Come before the Lord and ask him to transform and embolden us as we reach out to our "frontline" wherever that is. Give thanks for all who help to sustain the life of St Johns as volunteers. Pray for Clive and Mary. Pray for Little Gems.

*6th The god of this age has blinded the minds of unbelievers*

Pray that God will break through the spiritual blindness that we see around us. Pray for our families and our neighbours. Pray for David and Ivan, our Churchwardens and those who warden each service. Pray for Cafe Church. Pray for the Ash Wednesday Services.

*7th ...they saw his glory...*

Spend some time in worship of our glorious Saviour. Pray that all that we do will be in God's will and strength and not our own. Pray for his kingdom. Pray for those who offer prayer ministry in St Johns and elsewhere, including Healing on the Streets.

**Psalm 91:1-2, 9-16. Romans 10:8-14, Luke 4:1-13**

*8th I will say of the Lord "He is my refuge and my fortress"*

We each need to seek the guidance of God in all that we do and trust him to be with us as we obey. Pray for Sunday as we hear about "Moulding Outcomes" as part of our study on Fruitfulness on the Frontline. Pray for Healing on the Streets and the Town Pastors.

**Weekend Pray for your family**

*11th If you make the Most High your dwelling – even the Lord...*

Praise God for his love and faithfulness in our lives, our homes, our marriages and families, and welcome his coming into our lives. Pray that we the people of St Johns recognise the Lordship of Jesus and treat each other equally. Pray for Open Doors. Pray for The Hub.

*12th If you confess with your mouth "Jesus is Lord"...*

Are you being called to tell others of your faith – ask Jesus to give you the words to say. Pray for the ministry of St Johns to children and young people:- Pray for Andy and Michele. Pray for Clare. Pray for our outreach to schools through assemblies and Open the Book. Pray for our children and young people and their teachers and leaders. Pray for those who live or work in Highlands and the other residential and care homes in Woodbridge.

*13th How can they hear without someone preaching to them?*

Pray for opportunities to tell others of the love of God, forgiveness and salvation offered by God. Pray for those who find it difficult to accept that God loves them. Pray for the bereaved. Pray for our brothers and sisters in Christ who are being killed or persecuted for their faith. Pray for CPAS and the work among young people. Pray for the Wednesday congregation and for Freedom in Christ.

*14th Worship the Lord your God and serve him only*

Pray that we can stay focussed on God and reject the values of the society around us – such as greed and selfishness. Pray that each of us can take part in the ministry of encouragement to one another. Pray for the Gideons. Pray for Noelle, Lois and the office volunteers.

**Psalm 27, Philipians 3:17-4:1, Luke 13:31-35**

*15th The Lord is my light and my salvation – whom shall I fear*

Bring your worries and concerns to the Lord. Pray for your neighbourhood and neighbours and ways you can reach out to them. Pray for the Sunday teaching on being a Mouthpiece for Truth and Justice. Pray for the Town Pastors.

**Weekend Pray for God to bless your family**

*18th Hear my voice when I call, O Lord*

Give thanks that God has brought you to where you are. Pray for all who care for the environment – ourselves as individuals and for organisations. Pray for OMF, the Pawsons and Heather Cox. Pray for The Hub.

*19th Your face Lord I will seek*

Just sit for a while and let him minister to you. Pray for revival in this nation, which has become a desert, lacking knowledge of God and without love and compassion for one another. Pray for our part in this revival. Pray for the Sunday morning Congregation. Give thanks for those who clean the church, those who maintain it and those who decorate it with flowers making it a welcoming place week after week. Pray for Little Gems.

*20th Many live as enemies of the cross of Christ*

Pray for those who oppose God to be thwarted in their plans. Pray for this fractured nation to accept God's kingship and guidance. Pray for our musicians and all those who support the services in St Johns through sound and vision. Pray for Cry in the Dark. Pray for Freedom in Christ.
