29th From my birth I have relied on You...

Give thanks that we are each known by name by our Saviour. Pray that God will show you how you can play your part in His kingdom. Pray for this nation, that we will return to the Lord. Pray for food banks and for the Salvation Army and other organisations which reach out to the hungry and the homeless.

30th You have come to thousands...of angels in joyful assembly

Pray for God's kingdom to come on earth as in heaven. Give thanks that God has called you to be a part of this joyful assembly. Pray for the other churches and chapels in Woodbridge and Melton, their ministers and people. Pray for the people and church at Bredfield. Pray for the services in St Johns on Sunday. Pray for the Town Pastors.
