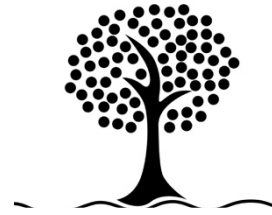
31st *God, have mercy on me, a sinner*
