

*Weekend - Pray for all those who are on your Frontline.*

**Jeremiah 23:1-6, Psalm 46, Colossians 1:11-20 Luke 23:33-43**

*25th The Lord Our Righteousness*

Give thanks that we have a Lord who saves us through his own righteousness. Pour out your sorrows to our Lord, whether they are your own or are on behalf of those you know or love. Pray for those in or affected by broken relationships. Pray for the Barnabas Fund. Pray for Hope Into Action. Pray for The Hub and the Gateway Cafe.

*26th God is our refuge and our strength*

Tell God your concerns for this world that he created and that we are ruining with climate change and increasing mountains of plastic. Ask Him how you can make a difference. Pray for Christian Aid and its work throughout the world. Offer God thanks that He hears you and will answer you. Let your heart be lifted by Him. Pray for Little Gems.

*27th He has rescued us from the dominion of darkness*

Lord, we so easily stray and do what we want; bring us back to you. Pray for deliverance for those caught up in human slavery and trafficking and for the Salvation Army and other organisations trying to combat this evil degradation of our fellow human beings. Pray for those addicted to drugs, alcohol, sex and other less obvious but very real temptations.

*28th Father forgive them for they do not know what they are doing*

Spend a few minutes in humble adoration of our Saviour. Pray that God will show you how you can play your part in His kingdom, telling others the good news of freedom from sin. Pray for this nation, that we will return to the Lord. Pray for food banks and for the Salvation Army and other organisations which reach out to the hungry and the homeless.

*29th He saved others; let him save himself*

Not only did Jesus save others - by his sacrifice on the cross he saved each one of us who believes in him. Give thanks and praise to Christ the King. Pray for the other churches and chapels in Woodbridge and Melton, their ministers and people. Pray for the people and church at Bredfield. Pray for the services in St Johns on Sunday. Pray for the Town Pastors. Pray for the Parenting for Faith Course.

*4th Hear the word of the Lord...listen to the law of our God*

Pray that God will show each of us where we can serve in the church and the community. Pray that all that we do will be in God's will and strength and not our own.
