Psalm 85, Colossians 2:6-15, Luke 11:1-13

25th Restore us again, O God our Saviour

Give thanks to the Lord for his love and care in this new season in the life of St Johns. Pray for Charles and Kate and their ministry in Woodbridge and Bredfield. Pray for the people of Ukraine and give thanks for the support being given to the refugees. Pray for those in or affected by difficult or broken relationships and by domestic violence. Pray for those who provide counselling and social care. Pray for Christian Aid. Pray for the Hub.

26th I will listen to what God the Lord will say

Ask God to guide us and that we obey his word. Pray for our work with young people through Friday Night Youth and other activities. Pray for Clare, our Children and Family Worker and those who work with her. Pray for Christian Aid and its work throughout the world.

27th Continue to live in him...overflowing with thankfulness

Spend some time in worship. Pray that this nation will come to recognise Christ's kingship. Pray for deliverance for those caught up in human slavery and trafficking and for the Salvation Army and other organisations trying to combat this evil degradation of our fellow human beings. Pray for those addicted to drugs, alcohol, sex, gambling and other less obvious but very real temptations.

28th God made you alive with Christ

Christ reigns on high and gives us life in him. Pray for prison ministry in its various forms and that prisoners can break free from the past. Pray for food banks and for the Salvation Army and other organisations which reach out to the hungry. Give thanks for the many people who give of their time and money to help those less fortunate.

29th Ask and it will be given you

We are called to trust and obey him. Pray for all the churches and chapels in Woodbridge and Melton, their ministers and people. Pray for the people and church at Bredfield. Pray for those whose health investigations and treatment has been delayed. Pray for the service at St Johns on Sunday morning .

4th O Lord my God, I called to you for help...

6th A man reaps what he sows

Pray that we will sow love and joy around us, that God may reap the harvest. Pray for those affected by earthquakes and other catastrophic events, especially warfare. Pray for the hungry and homeless and those who seek to help them. Pray for the Wednesday congregation.

7th Therefore...let us do good to all people...

Ask God to show you opportunities to do good. Pray for those struggling with pain and disability. Pray for those struggling mentally or financially especially in this time of rising prices and energy costs. Pray for the Bible Society. Pray for the Emergency Services.

8th Go! I am sending you out

Ask the Lord to be with you in reaching out to the community around us. Pray for the children and young people in this nation, that they will have the opportunity to hear about Jesus. Pray for the Sunday morning service, and Afternoon Praise.

11th Rescue the weak and needy

Ask God how you can help the poor and needy around us. Pray for healing of the world and of this nation from the effects of climate change. Ask God to show you what steps you can take. Pray for peace to return to Ukraine. Pray for those who live or work in residential and care homes in Woodbridge. Pray for the CPAS. Pray for the Hub.

12th They walk about in darkness

Pray that God will show you how you can be a light in the darkness around us. Pray for Open Doors. Pray for the continuing ministry of St Johns to children and young people. Pray for those who have left school to start work or are waiting results which will impact their future Pray for Little Gems.

13th Grace and peace to you from God our Father

Give thanks to God for his steadfast love. Pray for the Wednesday congregation. Pray for those from the Ukraine coming to the UK and their settling into new lives in this area. Pray for those who have offered to receive them. Pray for those who are bereaved and for the Support Group.

14th ...the love you have for all the saints

We are called to a life of service to our Lord and those he brings before us. Pray for the planning for the Sizewell Holiday. Pray for those who bring care to those who need it. Pray for those suffering from on-line bullying and abuse. Pray for those struggling with mental health issues, especially young people, that appropriate help is available. Pray for our brothers and sisters in Christ who are being killed or persecuted for their faith. Pray for Tear Fund.

15th Love your neighbour as yourself

Come before the Lord in sorrow and repentance for failing in our love for those around us and receive God's forgiveness, through the blood of our Saviour. Pray for farmers and those involved in food production. Pray for those going away on holiday and the impact of travel disruptions on their plans. Pray for the Big Family Day on Sunday and Presence in the evening.
