Community Focussed

26th This man welcomes sinners...

Pray that our churches will welcome all who come, whoever they are. Pray for Charles and his ministry in Woodbridge and Bredfield. Pray for those in or affected by difficult or broken relationships and by domestic violence. Pray for Christian Aid. Pray for the Hub.

27th He calls his friends and neighbours together

Pray that as we go out into our streets and neighbourhoods we are prepared to share Jesus. Pray for those who provide counselling and social care. Pray for our work with young people through Little Gems, Kingdom Kids, Friday Night Youth and other activities. Pray for Kate, our Children and Family Pastor and those who work with her. Pray for Christian Aid and its work throughout the world.

28th Rejoice with me I have found my lost sheep

Ask God to show you how you can share in his mission to the world. Pray for Alpha and those coming tonight. Pray for deliverance for those caught up in human slavery and trafficking and for the Salvation Army and other organisations trying to combat this evil degradation of our fellow human beings. Pray for those addicted to drugs, alcohol, sex, gambling and other less obvious but very real temptations.

29th There is rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents

Be open to God's leading and pray that he can use our everyday interactions to bring others into his kingdom. Pray for prison ministry in its various forms and that prisoners can break free from the past. Pray for food banks and for the Salvation Army and other organisations which reach out to the hungry.

1st This brother...was dead and is alive again, lost and is found

Ask God to fill us with desire to reach out to those who do not yet know Jesus. Pray for the peace of the Lord to be upon you, your family and your neighbours. Pray for the people and churches of St Johns and of St Andrews. Pray for those whose health investigations and treatment have been delayed. Pray for the morning services and for Presence.

19th Lord, teach us to pray...

Come to God prayerfully, wait on him and listen to him. Share with him your joys and concerns. Pray that we will fully follow God's commandments. Give thanks for God's provision for us. Pray for provisions for The Little Free Pantry and the Salvation Army food bank and for those who need to use them. Pray for the children and young people in this nation, that they will have the opportunity to hear about Jesus. Pray for Alpha.

22nd Forgive us our sins, for we also forgive...

Pray that we will each discern God's guidance in our lives. Pray for friends and neighbours, and that we may bring them closer to God's Kingdom. Pray for the Samaritans, and other organisations which reach out to help the suicidal and the desperate. Pray for the members of our various congregations. Pray for Cry in the Dark.

23rd Lead us not into temptation

Ask God to guide you in all that you do in his name and make us persistent in prayer. Pray for refugees and decisions being made about them. Pray for the homeless in this nation. Pray for Footsteps. Pray for Compassion and all the work they do. Pray for Friday Night Youth. Pray for the services on Sunday as we learn about opportunities to show practical love and give us wisdom in sharing Jesus with our neighbours.
